Visitors to Crocodylus Park can now learn how to hold a young crocodile. The park has introduced a new lesson, 'How to hold a young crocodile', which is a hands-on experience for visitors. The lesson is held in the park's crocodile enclosure, where visitors can see the crocodiles in their natural habitat. The lesson is led by a park guide, who will show visitors how to hold a young crocodile safely. The lesson is a popular attraction, and visitors are encouraged to book in advance.
